

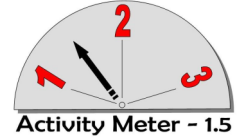

Tulip Time in Pella

1 Day: May 5, 2012



Join Pella residents as they celebrate their Dutch heritage with lowans and visitors from around the world at the **77th Pella Tulip Festival**. Savor the sights and sounds, smells and tastes of this colorful Iowa tradition. The town, major businesses and some community groups together order more than 200,000 tulip bulbs directly from the Netherlands, and that doesn't include all the private homes that have their own gardens. This quaint town should be ablaze with color!

We have **reserved grandstand seats** for the introduction of the queen and her royal court, street scrubbing of the parade route with water buckets and brooms, the Volks Parade (featuring floats, bands and Dutch specialty attractions) and Dutch dancers (dressed in native costumes, right down to their wooden shoes). We'll give you plenty of time to explore the Molengracht Canal area, reminiscent of the canals in the Netherlands, and browse craft booths in the park or Pella's quaint shops and specialty stores (maybe even buy a pair of wooden shoes). An optional old-fashioned wagon ride is a great way to take in all the tulips and local sights. If food is a priority with you, enjoy the many food stands, Dutch chocolate stores or popular bakeries. Our day includes a **special surprise** planned just for you.

Balance due: by April 5

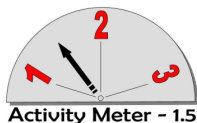
Cancel by: April 5 for penalty-free cancellations
