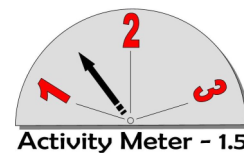


# Springtime in Branson

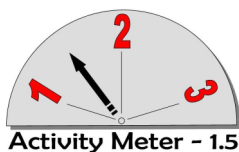
